H₂O to a greasy urn

Keeping baby and your produce clear of germs and bacteria is the aim of the **Lotus Sanitizing System** by Tersano, one of thousands of new products introduced last month at the International Home and Housewares Show in Chicago.

The Lotus uses ozonated water to sterilize vegetables, baby bottles and other items. The base unit

super-oxygenates water, which works within a covered bowl or, with the enclosed spray bottle and microfiber cleaning cloths, can be used to sanitize household surfaces. It comes with a booster cartridge. Suggested retail price is \$150. (www.tersano.com)
