Time magazine hails home sanitizing system as among top inventions of 2006

DEVELOPED BY WINDSOR MAN

Patience and ingenuity has led an Windsor, Ont., man to invent a home sanitizing system that was named this week by *Time* magazine as one of the top inventions of 2006. Using an electrical charge to infuse tap water with ozone, the system acts as a natural powerful sanitizer and removes the need for chemical use in

the home. Steve Hensperger said, "I had no idea how powerful ozonated water was and how it could be used as a more powerful sanitizer than hydrogen peroxide or any of the over-the-counter

bleaching and cleaning agents." So far, Mr. Hensperger and Tersano, the company he established to market the sanitizer, has sold about 20,000 units. *Can-West News Service*
